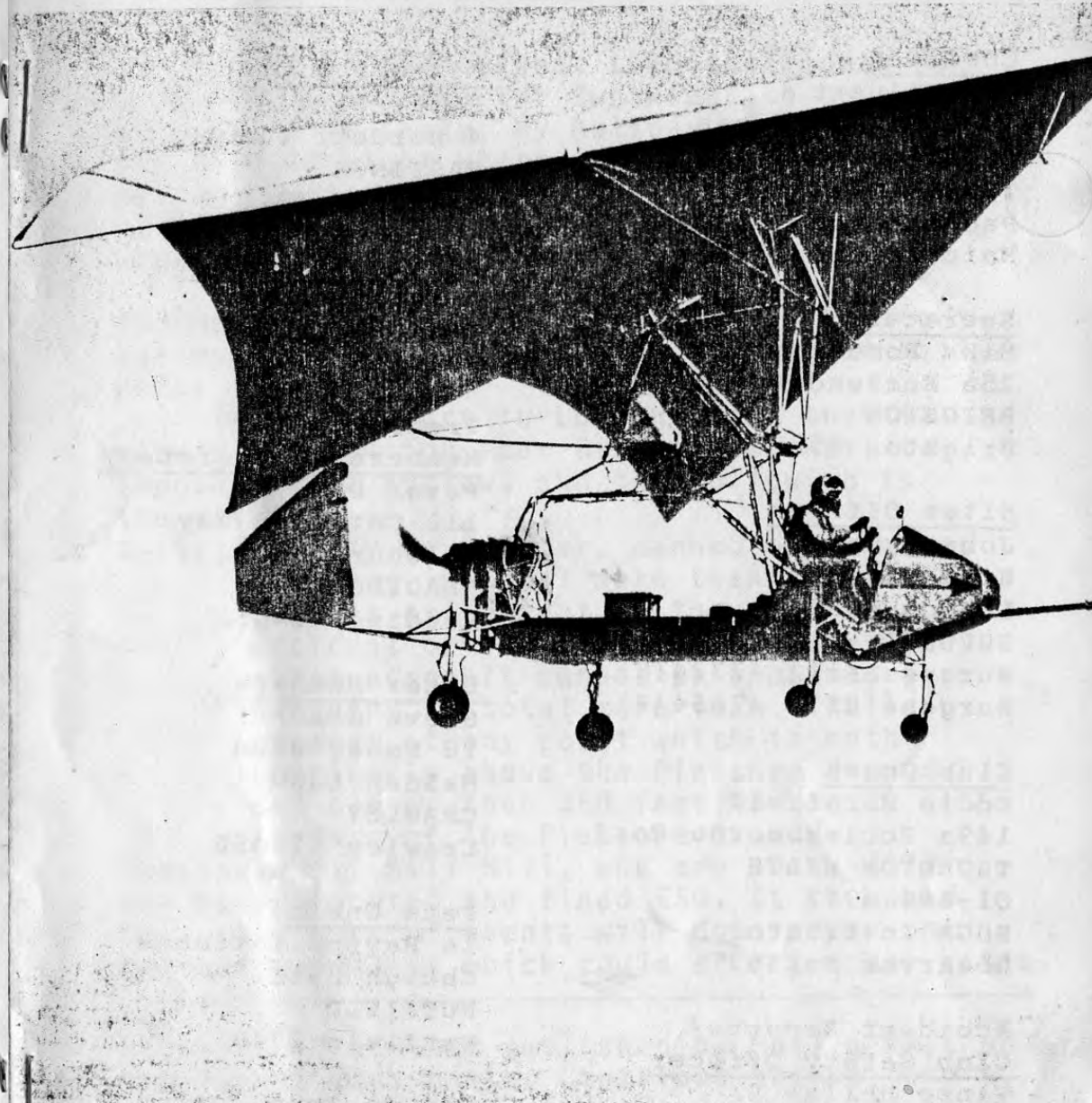

EDITORIAL

WINDSOCK is somewhat thin this month as I am off on holiday for two weeks so have had to prepare it early. My holiday destination is the Isle of Wight where I hope to get in some reasonable flying. When I return I will write up the Island's potential as a Pilot 1 soaring area.

The bad news this month is that the Southern Hang Gliding Club has lost its fight against a byelaw banning hang gliding at Mill Hill.

The High Court in London ruled that it wasn't illegal for Adur District Council to impose such a byelaw, and the following is the result:

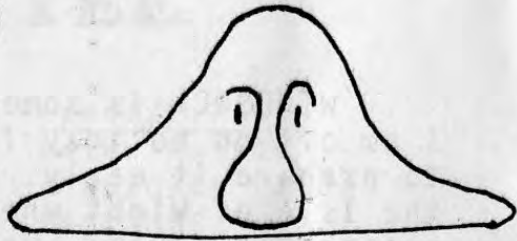
3(iii) NOT fly any glider, manned or unmanned weighing in total more than 4 killo-grammes or (except in the case of accident or other sufficient cause) any other aircraft manned or unmanned weighing in total more than 4 Killo-grammes at any point which is both vertically above the Pleasure Ground and closer than 350 feet to the surface of the Pleasure Ground.

Those who fly Mill Hill, and are seen, will now be prosecuted and fined £50. It is hoped that this turn of events will not set an unwelcome precedent which could effect other sites.

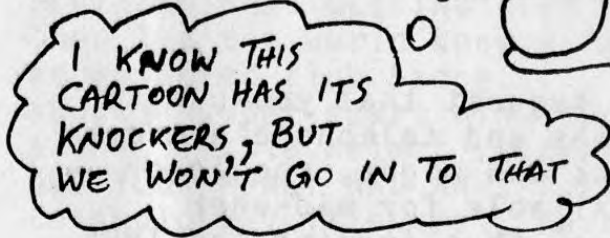

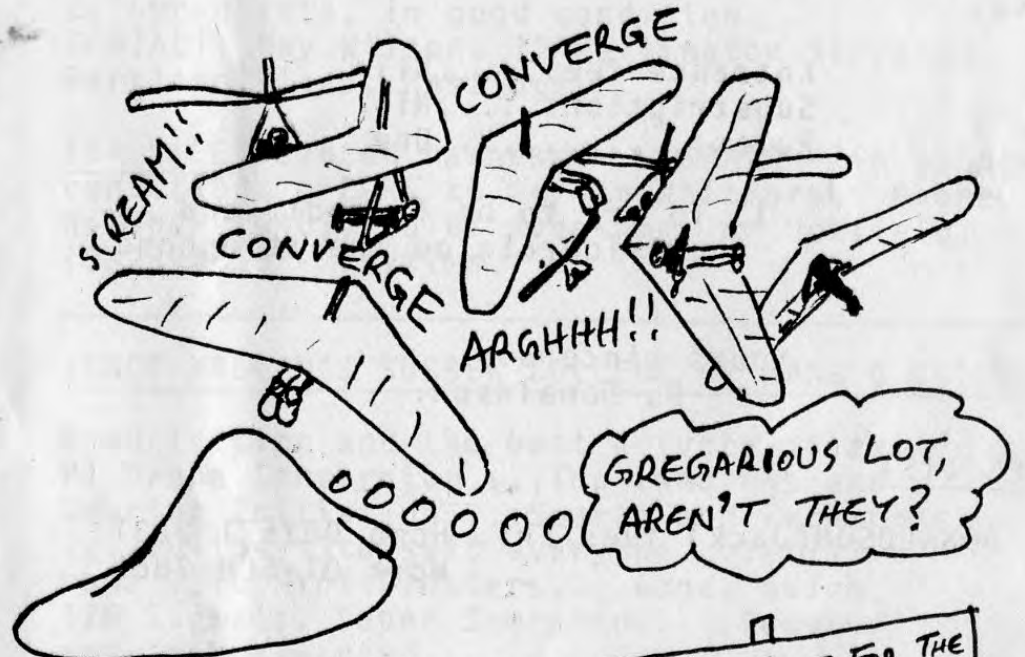
