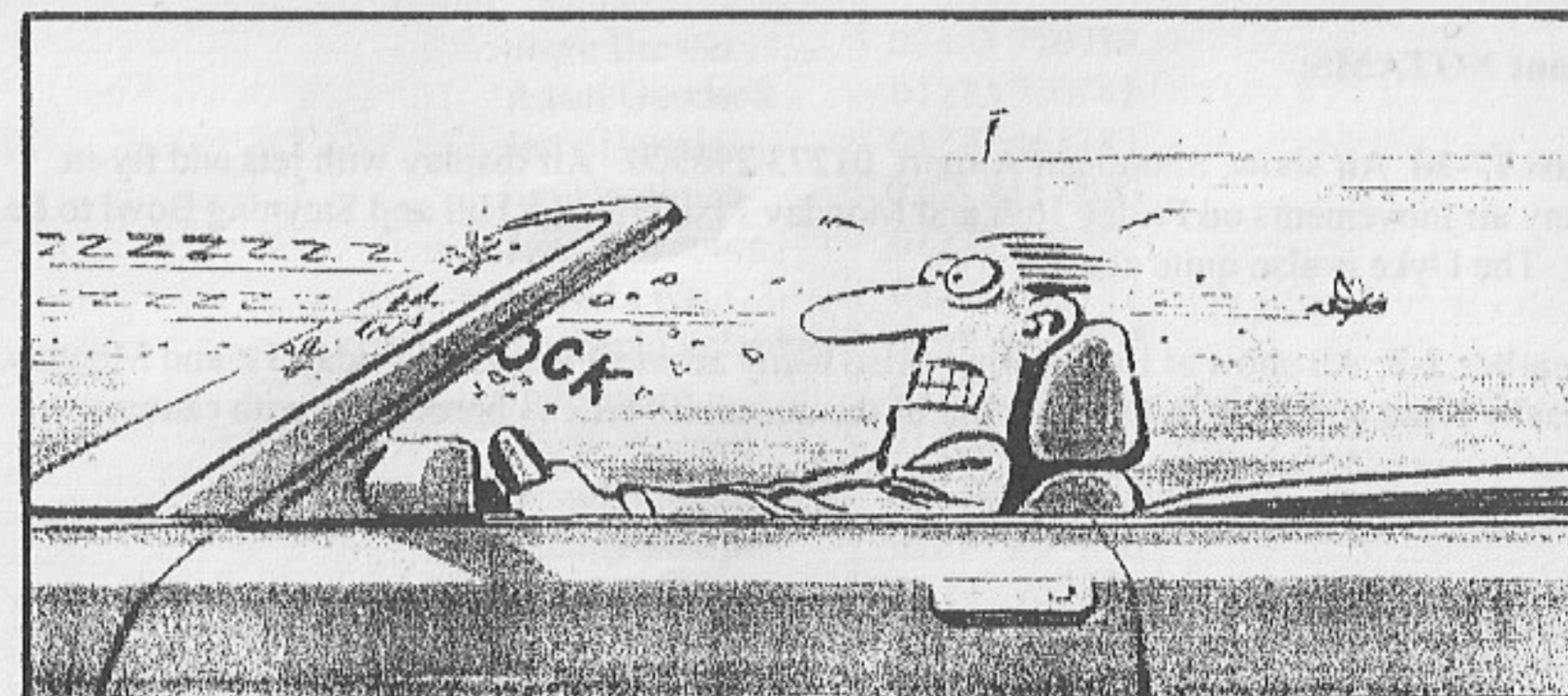
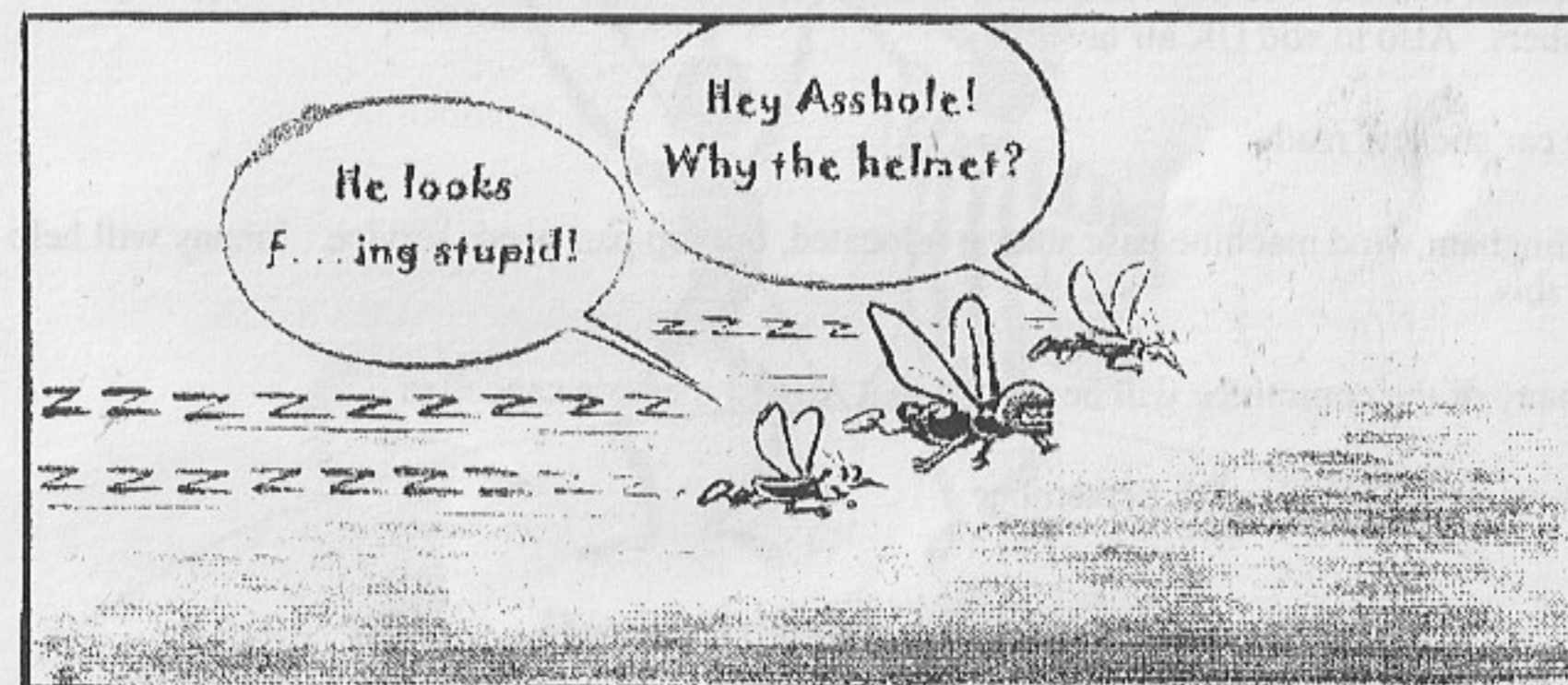
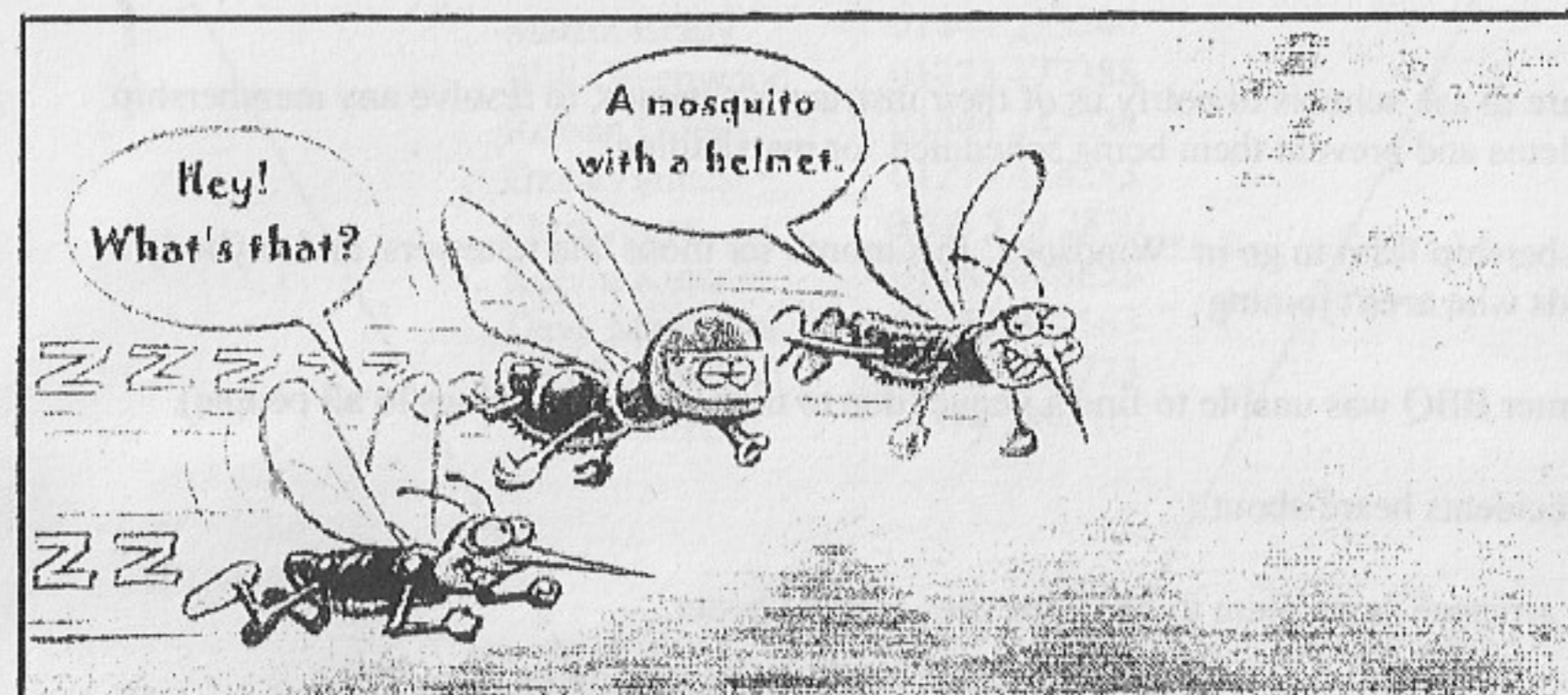
Finally Diana, your editor, would gratefully receive articles for 'Windsock' it would certainly make her life easier in putting together the mag. It would also make the mag an even greater read.
